

Current Service Update #2

April 4, 2019

Dear Customers,

The interruption of service at Jacintoport continues with no vessel traffic in or out of that section of the Houston Ship Channel.

National Shipping has managed to move all Voy. 151S cargo from Jacintoport to Barbour's Cut Terminal to be loaded tomorrow, April 5, on National Glory to sail the same night to Puerto Rico for delivery next Thursday, April 11th after operations at PRT on Wednesday, April 10th.

Barbour's Cut will start accepting loads for Voy. 152S starting Monday, 4/8, while chassis will have to be brought back to Jacintoport. Bookings that require a transfer will continue to be serviced at Jacintoport.

The call of Voy. 152S has now been arranged for Monday, April 15th, discharge and loading at Barbour's Cut as part of National Shipping's planned recovery to the original normal schedule by end April.

NSA will provide further direction for Voy. 153 in due course awaiting the all clear from USCG for the upper reach of the Houston Ship Channel at Jacintoport.

The NSA chassis pool will continue to be maintained at Jacintoport until further notice.
